

Regulations – María de Villota Charity Run – Festival de la Velocidad

The Run takes place within the Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya.

The race is open to everyone. The minimum age to participate is 16 years old. Participants under the age of 18 must have written consent from their legal guardian(s), who must provide a signed authorization when collecting the minor's race bib.

This is a charity run linked to the charitable initiatives that María de Villota launched before her passing on 11 October 2013.

The event supports the **Legado María de Villota** (<https://www.legadomariadevillota.com/>) and the **Fundación Ana Carolina Díez Mahou** (<https://www.acdm.es/>).

All proceeds generated by the run will be donated in full to the Legado María de Villota.

A **Race Bib 0** option will be available for those who wish to support the "**Primera Estrella**" programme without taking part in the race.

Distance

5 km race (one lap of the Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya track).

The course will be clearly marked, with kilometre markers every kilometre.

The maximum time allowed to complete the race is 60 minutes.

Timing and results will be managed using a race bib with an electronic timing chip.

The start will be organised into **two starting waves**:

- **Wave 1:** runners expecting to finish in under 25 minutes.
- **Wave 2:** all other participants.

The use of bicycles, skates, scooters or any other means of transport, as well as participation with pets, is strictly prohibited.

Registration will close at 11:59 p.m. on the Wednesday before the race, or earlier if the maximum limit of 1,000 registered participants is reached.

No registrations will be accepted on race day.

Once registration has been completed, the registration fee is non-refundable if the participant is unable to take part for reasons beyond the organiser's control.

The organiser reserves the right to modify the date and/or the course due to circumstances beyond its control or force majeure.

Only vehicles expressly authorised by the organiser will be permitted to accompany the race.

Race bib collection:

- Friday, 2 October, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., at the Accreditation Centre of the Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya, opposite the Main Entrance.
- On race day, Saturday, 3 October, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., at the Accreditation Centre of the Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya, opposite the Main Entrance.
- On race day, from 5:00 p.m. onwards, at the ticket office at Gate 3 of the Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya.

Failure to collect the race bib on the designated day will be deemed as forfeiture of the bib, the runner's gift bag, and participation in the race.

The 5 km race is part of the Lliga Champion Chip race series.

Participants must wear their race bib visibly on the front of their shirt at all times. Access to the runners' area on the Circuit track without a race bib is strictly prohibited.

Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in the overall men's and women's categories.

A commemorative race **medal** will be awarded to all participants who complete the event.

The **runner's gift bag** will be distributed after the race and is reserved exclusively for registered participants who have completed the event.

Admission to the Circuit on race day is not free of charge, except for registered participants, who may enter free of charge from 5:00 p.m. on Saturday.

Each registered runner may be accompanied by one guest.

Children aged 12 and under (inclusive) will be admitted free of charge and will not count as accompanying guests.

All persons entering the Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya will be accredited upon entry.

Drivers, mechanics and technical staff from the international teams participating in the motor racing events may also take part in the run.

Disqualifications

The event medical staff and the organiser's personnel are authorised to withdraw any participant who:

1. Shows signs of being physically unfit to continue.
2. Fails to complete the full course.
3. Displays unsportsmanlike behaviour.

Participation in the event is entirely at each participant's own risk and responsibility. Participants are responsible for ensuring that they are in suitable physical condition and good health to take part in an event of this nature. The organiser accepts no liability for any injury, loss or damage that participants may suffer, cause to themselves, or cause to third parties during the event.

Participants expressly authorise the publication of their name, surname, gender and year of birth in the list of registered participants and, if they complete the race, in the official results and rankings, in accordance with applicable legislation.

By registering, participants authorise the organiser, either directly or through third parties, to use photographs and video images taken during the event for promotional purposes, and to process their personal data for educational, sporting, promotional or commercial purposes only. In accordance with Spanish Organic Law 15/1999 of 13 December on the Protection of Personal Data, participants may exercise their rights of access, rectification and cancellation of their personal data by submitting a written request to **Escudería Targa Iberia** (Llacuna, 11, 08005 Barcelona).

By registering, participants declare that they have read and understood the Privacy Policy of Escudería Targa Iberia.

Registration implies full acceptance of these Regulations and of the Road Running Rules of the Catalan Athletics Federation. The organiser accepts no liability for any

loss, damage or injury arising from participation in the race. In all matters not expressly covered by these Regulations, the decision of the organiser shall be final.
